<u>AUGUST REINHARDT FARM</u> - Traveling north on Clove Road, from Rt. 206, the barn was located on the West side of Clove at the bottom of Reinhardt Road

<u>EDWARD LAVEAU FARM</u> – Traveling south on New Road, from Clove Road, right onto Red Hill Road and the barn was on the right.

<u>JAMES COLE FARM</u> – Traveling north on Clove Road, from Rt. 206, 4 miles in on left at the corner of New Mashipicong Road which is now the Zitone Farm.

<u>BOB WESTBROOK FARM</u> – Traveling north on Clove Road, from Rt. 206, 1 mile in on right, across from Millville Road. One barn still stands.

<u>LAUREL RIDGE FARM</u> – Traveling north on River Road, from Rt. 206, Just past the Grange on the west side of River Road and it ran up to Weider Road which is on the east side on the right.

<u>LLOYD COSS FARM</u> – Traveling north on Clove Road, from Rt. 206, 3.4 miles in on both sides of Clove Road. The foundation to the barn remains across from New Road to the left of the two story house.

<u>WILLIAMS FARM</u> – Traveling north on Clove Road, from Rt. 206, right on Birchtree; just before intersection with Deckertown, the farm was on the left. The stone house remains as a private residence.

<u>JOHN ARDLER FARM</u> – Traveling north on Clove Road, from Rt. 206, the farm was located on the corner of Deckertown & Clove Roads.

<u>KELLER FARM</u> – Traveling north on Clove Road from Rt. 206, approximately 4 miles on right onto Old Mashipicong, and approximately 3 miles up on right. Property is currently used by a non-profit and is currently farmed and in woodland management.

<u>WESTFALL FARM</u> – Traveling north on Clove Road from Rt. 206, approximately 5 miles on left. Barns still stand and property is now an animal sanctuary.
